### Withdrawals & Refund Requests

To withdrawal and request a refund, complete the [Withdrawal Form](#). All refunds will be processed **after** the competition.

- Refund minus **\$25** fee between **March 17-22, 2026**. A *medical note is required for athletes*.
- Refund minus **\$50** fee between **March 22-April 15, 2026**. A *medical note is required for athletes*.
- **Coaches** can withdrawal at any time before **April 15, 2026**. *No fees kept*.
- No refunds will be issued after **April 15, 2026**, except under special circumstances approved by GymBC.

## COACH INFORMATION

### Eligibility

All coaches must have the required NCCP certification and complete the Respect in Sport (RiS) program, as outlined in the [GymBC Coaching Education Operations Manual](#). GymBC will verify these for all registered coaches. Those coaching without proper certification during the event will face a \$200 fine. A one-time exemption may be requested until the next applicable NCCP course. For details, see the Coaching Education Operations Manual or email [coaching@gymbc.org](mailto:coaching@gymbc.org).

### Attire

Coaches must adhere to GymBC's attire guidelines in the [WAG Operations Manual](#), maintaining a professional image during warm-up and competition.

## COMPETITION INFORMATION - WAG

### Categories, Eligibility, and Awards

Category	Eligibility	Awards
CCP 3-5	Minimum of 32.00 AA with verifiable online results prior to registering for the event. Petitions are not accepted.	<b>Team:</b> Club awards (1-3) for each level. Min 3 athletes per club, all birth years combined. Top 3 scores on each apparatus to count <b>By category and by competitive age groupings:</b> Medal 1-3, Ribbon 4-10 (AA and Apparatus) Plaque AA Champion

### Restrictions

If there is only one competitor in any one (1) category, only an all-around award will be given. If there are two or more competitors, all awards will be given.

### Category Grouping

Following athlete registration, athletes will be grouped by category and birth year. Each competitive grouping will ideally include approximately 24 athletes. Groupings will not be changed once the official schedule for the event is circulated.

### Tie-Breaking

There is no tie-breaking rule. If there is a tie, the following position is skipped. For example; if there are two athletes tied for second place, there will be no third place awarded. The next athlete in rank order will receive the fourth-place award.
