ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	 All athletes registering for the 2024 Compulsory Gymnastics BC Championships will be verified by Gymnastics BC. Any athlete who is not registered properly (i.e. not in the correct category, registered as interclub or recreational, etc.) will be subject to a \$200 fine (charged to the club) and may be ruled ineligible for the championships. Please see specific eligibility requirements below. As indicated in the GymBC Registration Handbook, a club may not change the category of an athlete after March 1, 2024. It is the club's responsibility to ensure that all athletes are registered in the appropriate category by that date. If you have any questions regarding your athletes and their categories, please contact membership@gymbc.org prior to the March 1 deadline. 			
COACH ELIGIBILITY	 MCCP Certification All coaches must have the appropriate NCCP certification to be on the field of play as per the GymBC Coaching Education Operations Manual as well as successful completion of the Respect in Sport (RiS) program. Coaching certification and RiS completion will be verified by Gymnastics BC for all coaches registered for the competition. Coaches with inadequate certification will be contacted to advise them of the situation. Any coach with missing certification who is found to be coaching on the field of play during the event, will be subject to a \$200 fine. Coaches not meeting the minimum level of certification may apply for a one-time exemption. The exemption will be granted until the next applicable NCCP course(s) is/are offered. 	 CCP Levels 1,2,3,4,5 Athletes categories will be grouped by birth year(s). Ideally, groupings for awards will be balanced with a maximum of approximately 24 in any given level/birth year. Athletes registered in level/birth year with few participants will be grouped together. No changes to the groupings will be made once they are circulated with the final schedule.

RESTRICTIONS	If there is only one competitor in any one (1) category, only an all-around award will be given. If there are two or more competitors, all awards will be given.			
TIE-BREAKERS	There is no tie-breaking rule. If there is a tie, the following position is skipped. For example; if there are two athletes tied for second place, there will be no third place awarded. The next athlete in rank order will receive the fourth-place award.			
WARM UP PROCEDURES	Please review the GymBC Warm-Up Procedures found in the <u>BC CCP Charts and Xcel Program Manual.</u>			
JUDGES	 Judges assigned at the 2024 Compulsory BC Championships (or at any other meet) must be registered as judges with Gymnastics BC. The organizing committee (host club) will pay for transportation and accommodation of all judges. 			
COMPETITION ATTIRE (COACHES)	 Coaches must be dressed according to GymBC Guidelines; outlined in the WAG Operations Manual. In order to maintain a professional image, coaches are required to abide by the regulations for attire while on the competition floor, during warm-up and competition: Appropriate club/team uniform; T-shirt, polo shirt, or training jacket; appropriate indoor sport footwear; and No hats, sandals, slippers, shorts, crop tops, tank tops, jeans, rippled, or torn clothing or similar Coaches dressed inappropriately will receive a warning from the Competition Head Judge. The coach will have 30 minutes to comply.
